WASHINGTON COUNTY SCHOOLS APPROVES 2024/2025 CALENDAR



At the February 1st board meeting, the Washington County School District approved the school calendar for the 2024/2025 school year. This approval was in response to employee input. School district employees were given 4 options and provided a window to vote for their option. There were sufficient votes for each option, with no option being overwhelmingly preferred.

Consequently, a hybrid version for the 2024/2025 year was developed for presentation to the Board for approval. All options provided students and staff with limited instructional disruption and a focus on student achievement.

The school district has also highlighted its investment in their instructional staff by including 10 professional learning days in the year. Superintendent Harden recommended that two of the traditional professional learning days become Asynchronous Learning days. While students are participating in an at-home learning model, staff will participate in a joint training and instructional support day. District IT and Digital Learning staff will support virtual learning capabilities by using these days to further develop, test, and implement student focused digital technologies.

Additionally, IT staff will ensure that school level technology is functioning as required to allow teachers and school staff to virtually deliver instruction to students. These Asynchronous Learning days will allow students to better prepare for digital learning days and will provide staff the time to focus on their own digital teaching skills in an individualized way.

“Over the past few years, Virtual Learning Days have become the norm when school districts are unable to conduct school in the usual face-to-face manner. We strive to ensure that our digital learning model be as robust as possible. As a Strategic Waiver District, we are pleased to be able to introduce this innovative approach to the continued development of our students’ technology skills while at the same time investing in our own skills to deliver instruction through digital means. It is important that we continue to be prepared to transition between learning models, if necessary,” Harden stated.

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Superintendent Harden also announced that the first day of pre-planning for the 2024/2025 year will be a self-directed professional learning day. Schools will be open for teachers and staff who wish to work on campus. In addition, several on-line professional development options will be available for those who choose to remotely access learning opportunities.

The calendar maintains 180 days of instruction for students and adheres to state requirements. The approved calendar is on the next page of this release.
